

IWO Weekend Workcamp

DATE:

9-12th, May, 2019 (From Thu-Sun)

LOCATION:

Big tree local children Center at Jucheon, Yeongwol, Gangwon-do, Korea

OBJECTIVE:

- Provide assistance to the locals through voluntary service.
- Provide a chance for international exposure to the local residences.
- Understanding Korean culture and lifestyle.
- Get out of the comfortable daily life and refresh in the green surrounding.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The program will take place in Yeongwol, Gangwon-do province. The duration is 2 nights and three days in a local children center. The local children center makes a fundraising through farming in aronia(choke berries) field and corns. Hence, local youth economically disadvantaged will get a scholarship from local children center to go higher education opportunity. The participants will engage in farming, i.e. removing weeds in the aronia (choke berries) fields and harvesting corns. They will also have times to visit the traditional night markets and other traditional spots to better understand and learn about Korean culture and lifestyle. The visitation sites include:

- a) **Yeongwol Seobu Market:** Located in the center of Yeongwol
- b) **Hanbando Landscape:** A natural landscape that looks like the Korean Peninsula
- c) **Donggang:** A well naturally preserved river

ITINERARY (DRAFT)

Day 1	Morning	Gathering at meeting point and moving to project site - by public transportation
	Afternoon	Orientation & manual work in the farm - sharing locations, dos and donts etc - aronia (choke cherries), corn and peach farms
	Evening	Barbeque night - food and grills will be provided

Day 2-3	Morning	Manual work in the farm - aronia (choke cherries), corn and peach farms
	Afternoon	International Food Day and manual work in the farm - basic ingredients will be provided
	Evening	Free time - Seobu Night Market
Day 4	Morning	Manual work in the farm and cleaning surroundings - cleaning rooms, wash rooms, kitchen, etc. - aronia (choke cherries), corn and peach farms
	Afternoon	End of camp
